

IN HOUSE FACILITATOR TRAINING

I provide this in 2 parts. This can prevent agencies from wasting money by training staff who will never facilitate the programme.

The first part is a one day Introduction to the Freedom Programme. I provide this for a maximum of 40 trainees. Price plus vat on application. These trainees could be potential facilitators or could potentially refer service users to your programmes.

Each trainee receives a free copy of my book 'Living with the Dominator' and is instructed to bring this to the training. On the day, I also provide each trainee with a copy of 'The Freedom Programme Home Study Course' which they can use one to one with their service users.

The host agency provides the venue and the catering. I need a room which will hold 40 chairs in 5 small circles.

The trainees who attend this can then decide if they wish to complete the next two days and to become facilitators.

I then offer the next 2 days for a minimum of 20 or a maximum of 40 trainees. Price plus vat on application. This price includes a copy of the Facilitator's Manual. Again the host agency provides the venue and the catering. As the second day includes a performance of the play, 'Lady in Red' we have specific requirements for the venue.

These are the requirements for the venue:

- We need parking for our van which is handy so we can unload the lights and the stage set.
- We need to be able to black out the windows.
- We need a lift unless the venue is on the ground floor.
- We need complete silence for the duration of the play so the local brass band must not book the next room for their weekly practice session!
- We need a room to sit about 40 people in small circles which we can move around.

Apart from that space, we also need an area of 20' x 20' (6M x 6M) to perform the play.
